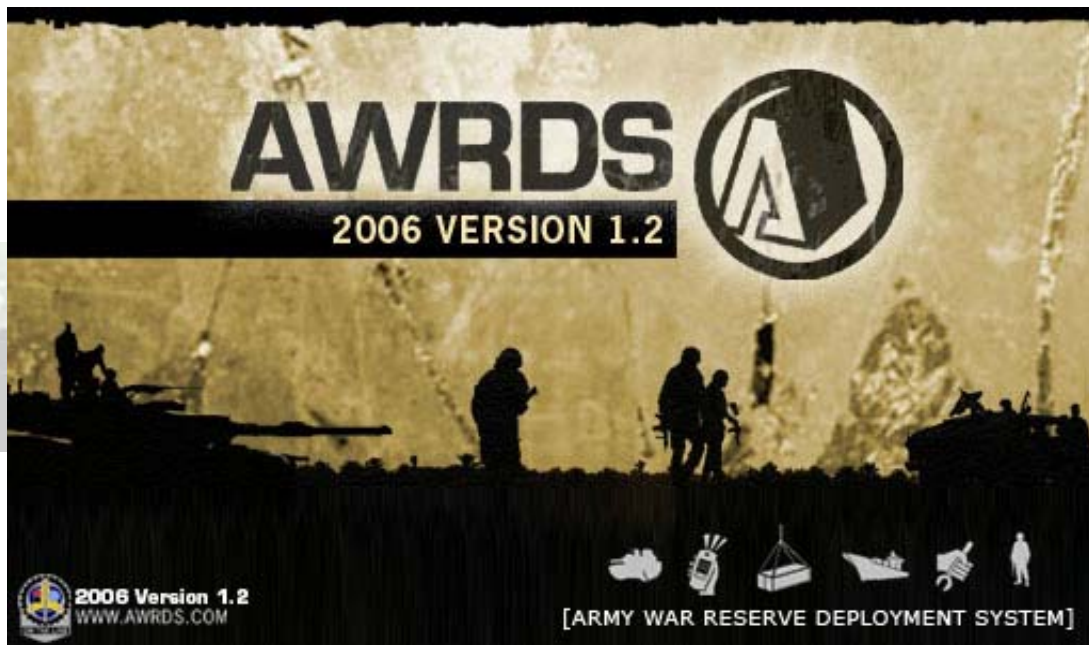

AWRDS 2006v1.2.0 Release Notes

Release Overview

The 2006v1.2.0 release is designed to add the new Property Book Interface functionality to the AWRDS system. The interface consists of the Property Book Export and Import. This version is to be applied on top of the current 2006v1.1.3 release.

New AWRDS Capabilities

1) **Property Book Interface (PBUSE/AWRDS) (SCR# 1265): Export:** The new Property Book Export module allows the user to generate an .xml file with issued equipment data for import into PBUSE. The user may export single or multiple UICs and individual pieces of equipment within those UICs to the file. The .xml file may be saved and sent using most media types including email, CD, thumb drive, and disk when being passed to the PBO. The system will produce an invalid record report for the user before the file is generated. The report will list all selected records that conflict with the established schema rules regarding serial number, USA number, and Lot number. Records that do not have a document number will not be exported; all other records will be stripped of their offending data elements. The system will allow the user to export the same pieces of equipment multiple times if required due to file corruption, data errors, and other problems. Notes: The UIC and DODAAC must be identical in AWRDS and PBUSE before the equipment is issued. The export file name must be in the following format: (Gaining UIC)_AWRDS_YYMMDD. For example, "WRX9AA_AWRDS_070302".

Import: The new Property Book Import allows the user to import an .xml file containing equipment data from PBUSE into AWRDS. The user will select the plan the equipment is to be imported into. The user will also select the default Project CD, Ownership Purpose CD, Condition CD, and Depot UIC of the incoming records. Prior to populating the reconcile window the system will validate the import file for valid UICs and NIINs. Invalid records will be displayed in the Invalid Record widow. The user may stop the import and

correct the appropriate reference tables, or continue with the import. Invalid records will not be imported into the reconcile window.

Within the Reconcile window the system will display records to be inserted, records already inserted and a record edit window. The user may import individual or all incoming records into the Equipment List. If desired the user may edit the Equipment List record after the records has been inserted. Note: The .xml file must be imported into an empty plan.

- 2) Hand Receipt Update (SCR# 1272):** The USA_NO (registration number) has been added to the hand receipt in place of the UPARMR field.

Other Notes

Future Enhancements: The full reconcile function of the Property Book Import will be completed for the 2007v1 release. This will allow sites to keep a historical record of issued equipment to reconcile against incoming records from PBUSE. The user will be able to receive and update existing equipment list records through the import file. The user will also be able to search other plans for serialized assets. A Web service to automate the transfer of files back and forth from AWRDS and PBUSE will be developed and deployed at a date TBD.
